

Clovis West High School Instrumental Music 2022-2023 Performance Attire

Students & families will be responsible for obtaining their own concert attire. Please communicate any issues meeting these uniform requirements with your director as soon as possible.

Wind Symphony, Symphonic Band, Chamber Orchestra, & String Orchestra

“Concert Black” Options:

- **Tuxedo:**
 - White Dress Shirt (Wing Collar or Standard Collar)
 - Black Bow Tie
 - Black Dress Pants & Black Tuxedo/Suit Jacket
 - Long Black Socks
 - Black Dress Shoes
- **Dress:**
 - Solid black floor length dress with $\frac{1}{4}$ length sleeve or longer (shoulders covered).
 - Closed-toed, black dress shoes in CUSD dress code. Low heels (2 inches or less) or flats.
- **Blouse & Slacks:**
 - Solid black dress pants & solid black blouse with $\frac{1}{4}$ length sleeve or longer (shoulders covered).
 - Closed-toed, black dress shoes in CUSD dress code. Low heels (2 inches or less) or flats.

6th Period Concert Band: Formal & All Black

Options:

- Any of the “Concert Black” that the other ensembles wear is also acceptable.
- Solid black dress pants & solid black collared, long sleeve shirt.

Additionally:

- Closed-toed, black dress shoes in CUSD dress code. Low heels (2 inches or less) or flats.
- If your shoes require socks, wear long, black socks or stockings.
- Dress shirts should be tucked in. If slacks have loops for a belt, wear a black belt.
- Ties and jackets are optional, but should be black if you choose to wear them. Neck ties or bow ties are acceptable.
- If you choose to wear an undershirt, it should be black.

Clovis West Music Directors are more than willing to discuss ways that *all students* can succeed in the Clovis West Instrumental Music Program and support students accordingly. Failure to meet these requirements may disqualify a student from participating in the performance/event at the director’s discretion. The Instrumental Music Department can help assist students and families that may be unable to meet these requirements. Timely communication is key-- please contact your director immediately as soon as you become aware of a need.
